In the parking lot at the Harbor Springs IGA

Mackinaw City
Behind the Schools and the Recreation Complex, where Perrot Street meets Pond

Day-to-day Recycling in Two Streams

Papers, Boxes & Bags Stream



Cardboard and Paper Bags
• YES! Boxes from frozen and refrigerated foods; boxboard — like cereal boxes and paper towel cores
• Please flatten boxes
• NO foam items, or other packing materials

Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs and Books
• All okay: hardcover, paperback and phone books

Office Paper
• YES! Envelopes, file folders and shredded paper
PLEASE CONTAIN ALL SHREDDED PAPER IN A TRANSPARENT PLASTIC BAG.

Plastic Grocery and Bread Bags
• **STRETCHY, CLEAN AND DRY ONLY!**
• **BAG YOUR BAGS** — stuff all your plastic bags into one bag and tie it shut
• Also okay: case wrap (as used on multipacks of water bottles, paper towel rolls), bubble wrap, plastic envelopes
• NO chip/pretzel bags, metallic bags, or cellophane


Mixed Containers Stream

Juice Boxes, Milk Cartons and Paper Cups
• NO juice pouches or straws
• YES! Ice cream tubs

Plastic Bottles, Jugs and Jars, Tubs, Trays and Cups
• Any plastic containers 2.5 gallons or less
• YES! Plastic caps and lids, on their container, are now recyclable.
• NO foam items
• NO non-container plastic items

Metal Cans, Foil and Trays
• Metal lids, too
• NO aerosol cans or propane tanks
• NO non-container metal items

Glass Bottles and Jars
• All colors and clear
• NO light bulbs, window glass, or glass dishes
• NO non-container glass items

Curbside pickups will be one day later than usual for the rest of the week following Memorial Day, Labor Day and Thanksgiving. Also, if New Year's Day, Independence Day, or Christmas Day falls on a weekday, it will bump curbside pickups one day later for the rest of the week.




Tires[§]

Max 4 ft diameter, 12" wide



Rubble and Ceramic Fixtures[§]
• Bricks, concrete, asphalt and ceramics including sinks, etc.
• Rebar and wire mesh okay
• Please remove seats, faucets, etc. from fixtures
• **NO** lead paint or asbestos



Large Appliances[§]



Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Freezers and Refrigerators[§]
Fee applies if not tagged by a certified technician—as required by law before recycling or disposal to prevent release of refrigerants.




Scrap Metal FREE!
NO propane or vehicle tanks



Small Metal Appliances
Please throw away removable parts not made of metal



Extremely Large Cardboard FREE!



Brush, Logs, Pallets[§]
• Nails okay
• **NO** treated wood, plywood, particle board or finished wood



Yard Waste FREE!
Plant material under 1 inch in diameter, i.e. weeds, stems, leaves, grass clippings and twigs





Latex Paint[§]
• Easy! No need to mix in anything or wait for it to dry
• Accepted Apr 1 to Nov 1



Mattresses, Springs and Futons[§]
Very dirty, musty or wet ones must be landfilled and charged for accordingly.



Plant Plastics FREE!
Cell packs, flats and pots
• Please tap out soil and stack like with like
• Accepted Apr 1 to Nov 1



Plastic Buckets and Totes FREE!
Remove metal parts and recycle on the scrap metal pile



Bulky Film Plastic FREE!
Including boat wrap, clean and dry polyethylene film/sheeting

Antifreeze[§]



Batteries
• All kinds accepted (tape the terminals of lithium and/or 9V or greater)
• Household batteries are also collected at nine stores. For locations visit EmmetRecycling.org
• Batteries from Emmet County households FREE; fee applies to others[§]



Electronics[§]
Electronics are fully recycled by a third-party certified processor. Beware of the many electronics "recyclers" who sell the valuable parts and discard the rest, including toxic materials.



TVs and Monitors[§]
Collected in the Waste drive-through bay



Fluorescent and LED Light Bulbs
• Compact fluorescent bulbs okay
• **NO** broken bulbs
• Bulbs from Emmet County households FREE; fee applies to others[§]



Food Scraps

Food Scraps FREE!
• Fruit & vegetable trimmings
• Meat, fish & bones
• Coffee grounds & filters, tea leaves
• Bread, pasta, beans & rice
• Cheese, milk & pizza box liners
• Nuts & nut shells
• **NO** plastic unless BPI Certified
• **NO** twist ties
• **NO** stickers or labels
• **NO** wrappers or toothpicks

Cooking Oil and Grease FREE!
• Raw fats are okay too.
• Empty into the black cooking oil tank
