NextCycle Flows: DPW staff has made progress this year on the compost facility through the FLOWS project. A McMurry and A Tolzdorf are presenting in June at a pitch competition with a chance to win \$10,000 towards the project.

GFL/LTD: GFL is operating as two separate entries as they split Emmet County, one based out of Elmira and one based out of Cheboygan. Their 60 day grace period will be up at the end of the month.

MRC Conference: DPW staff attended the annual Michigan recycling conference last week. There was a lot of discussion about Part 115 requirements and the Alpena MRF project.

Operating License: A.Tolzdorf is working with to get a bond for financial assurance for the license that is due in July.

Other Business (NEW BUSINESS)

Pick-up truck Purchase: DPW has found a truck that meets the department's needs and fits the MI Deals requirement. The DPW board recommends to the administrator to purchase this pick-up truck with meets MI Deals requirements. B. Gutowski made a motion. A. Bawkey supported. All voted in favor.

PHSACF Grant: This grant is to improve Emmet County Recycling's event recycling services by purchasing new bins for food waste collection and recyclables as well as improve educational materials. D. fuller moved that we accept the grant. Supported by A. Bawkey. All voted in favor.

Calmer Construction: DPW board has instructed staff to look into the references of this applicant.

Removed Waste: Due to long term outstanding balances of this account, the board has asked staff to put this customer on a cash only account.
