Materials Management Planning (MMP) is a program that guides counties in managing materials like food waste, yard clippings, recyclables, and solid waste, with a focus on sustainable practices such as recycling and composting.

It supports safe disposal options and aligns with a new Michigan law establishing statewide recycling goals and standards. The MMP will outline strategies to achieve those goals.
